Notes:

1. 23.6 miles, mostly flat with long downhill sections on Rte 29 return, 2 hour round trip ride time.
2. This trip sheet is paired with the map image: Stockton NJ to Frenchtown NJ MAP.jpg.
3. This trip follows the Delaware and Raritan Feeder Canal Trail (D&R) and Rte 29 in New Jersey.
4. Optional return trip can be made substituting Southbound D&R Trail for Rte 29.
5. Road surfaces: asphalt, packed dirt and packed gravel.
6. Parking at Stockton NJ Visitors Center/Prallsville Mill, Geo-coordinates: 40.409095, -74.984901.
7. Food and mechanical service is available in Frenchtown NJ.
8. Restrooms available at Stockton NJ Visitors Center, Bulls Island, Kings Wood Park and Frenchtown NJ.

Hazards:

1. Hazard: The D&R canal makes use of several metal gates that block the trail where they intersect with roads. Riders must go around these gates at a slow speed because the passage is both narrow and often partially obstructed with rocks or other debris. Riders must also be wary of motor vehicles passing near these gates.
2. Hazard: The D&R trail is widely used for recreation by pedestrians and bike riders of many skill levels. It is not uncommon to find the trail blocked by people and pets standing and talking.
